



One Small Key...

The One Small Key initiative is a collaborative project of EDEN and Mental Health Services (MHS) to open the door to a future of self-sufficiency and healing for 180 individuals and families who are currently living in our community's homeless shelters.

In an unprecedented effort, 180 Shelter Plus Care vouchers will be made available this spring to 180 disabled individuals or families who need permanent housing and on-going case management support to get back on their feet after falling into homelessness.

The Shelter + Care Vouchers will subsidize monthly rents so that clients will be able to afford their own apartments, while also receiving case management assistance to help them with their disability and to prevent them from becoming homeless again.

Moving 180 individuals and families out of shelters in a short period of time requires an extraordinary effort and the help of our many generous community supporters.
